Hilltop Handspun, located in Lovell, Maine, is owned and operated by fiber artist and designer, Lucy Rogers. Lucy enjoys creating and selling hand made yarn to hand knitters and fiber and roving to hand spinners and felters. The yarn and spinning fibers are made from alpaca, mohair, wool and angora fleeces that are hand selected from Maine and New England farms. Many of her designer yarns she hand spins and a number are spun at a local mini-mill often on a fleece by fleece basis. Beautiful colors come to life during the hand dyeing process in Lucy's kitchen.
